- A limit of 6 runs per person. (Possibly more depending on availability)
- Event will be run under the Rules & Regulations of Bundarra Show Society.
- All competitors compete at their own risk.
- Divisions are: Open (over 18 years), Juvenile (over 12 and under 17 yrs), Junior (under 12 yrs), Mixed.
- All Junior and Juvenile riders must wear a helmet (AS/NZ 3838) with strap secured at any time around a horse.
- Cancellations after the 25th of January are non-refundable unless proof of injury or illness.
- All nominations must be received by the 25th of January.
- Team payments are to be paid with nominations.
- Entry Fee: Open \$20 per person per run: Juvenile \$15 per person per run: Junior \$10 per person per run. Price includes \$5 cattle levy.
- All riders under the age of 18 must state their age on the entry form.
- Any Junior riding is not permitted to ride in the OPEN division.
- Only a limited amount of runs are available.
- **You are required to fill in a Stabling Application Form and submit it with this entry form.** Note that horse stalls and camping spots are limited so it's advisable to do this ASAP.
- **You are required to fill in a Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration and submit it with this entry form.**

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.** Riders & Handlers MUST sign Indemnity Waivers before competing. PIC numbers will need to be recorded as well. Forms will be at Ring Office & Secretary's Office.
- 2.** All entries are accepted on the basis that all competitors compete solely at their own risk. HORSE OWNERS-it is in your interest to have your own Public Risk Insurance.
- 3.** All riders under 18yrs must wear an approved safety helmet while riding & competing on Bundarra Showground.
- 4.** While every effort will be made to follow the program the Stewards reserve the right to change scheduling if needed.
- 5.** All competitors & ribbon winners are requested to participate in the Grand Parade.
- 6.** Entry Fees are applicable to all competitors.
- 7.** The Society will provide a measurer but will also accept a Measurement Certificate of Height, Current EFA & current Show Horse Council certificates. Measurer will be in attendance on Saturday morning & at request during the show.
- 8.** A Pony is not exceeding 14hh, Galloway is over 14hh & not exceeding 15hh, Hack Is over 15hh
- 9.** All Breeds & Classifications must be registered and financial members. Papers must be available if requested.
- 10.** Definitions:  
Maiden Hack-Galloway-Pony, is one that has not won a first prize in a Hack Class  
Novice Hack is open to horses that have never won an Open Champion at a recognised show  
Intermediate Hack is open to horses that have never won a first prize at a Royal Show
- 11.** Competitors MUST choose if their horse is either Adults or Childs Hack, they may not compete in both
- 12.** Show Hunter Horses: Horses that compete as Show Hunter are ineligible to compete as Hacks .
- 13.** The Committee stipulates that entrants pay attention to correctness of dress & equipment for events in which they are participating and abide by the rules and regulations that are set within their associations.
- 14.** Stallions may only compete in classes provided. No Stallions in Hack or Hunter Classes.
- 15.** In Age events proof of age must be available if required by the Stewards.
- 16.** Junior Competitors (under 13yrs) shall not be requested to dismount under judging.
- 17.** Local Classes: Horses must be owned and permanently stabled within Bundarra Shire (2359 postcode) and ridden by a local resident or committee member. Riders can only compete as local if they do not plan to, and have not competed elsewhere as a Local.  
Bundarra Pony Club riding members under 17 years may also compete as a local.
- 18.** All protests must be in writing and given to the Ring Master or Chief Ring Steward within the hour after an award has been made, with a deposit of \$25 which may be forfeited if the protest is dismissed

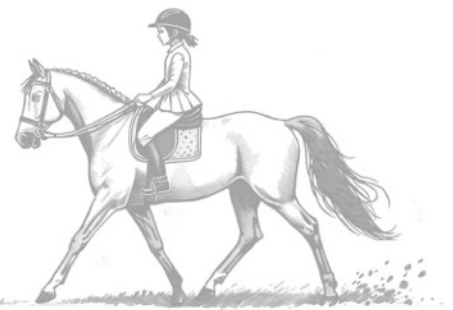

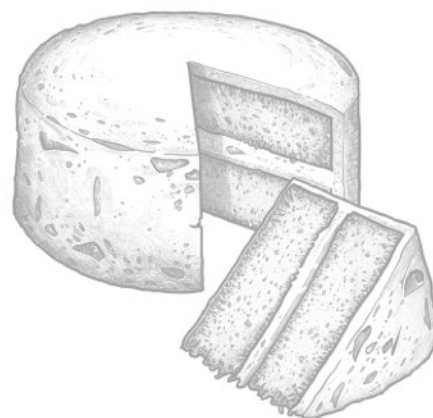

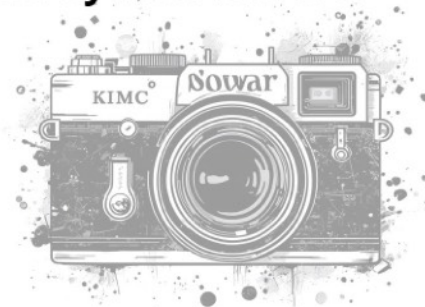
#### A note regarding enhancements -

**Enhancement Accepted** - In most of the categories enhancement is accepted - this means that we will accept any amount of dodging, burning (selectively lightening and darkening elements) and other basic enhancements (contrast, saturation etc). However combining different elements, changing backgrounds etc is not allowed.

**In the creative section we allow everything, no rules.**

**No manipulation - In the landscape / seascape / cityscape** the objective is to present the image in it's purest form. This means that you can change the contrast and exposure but no dodging and burning is accepted (that means selectively lightening or darkening the image).

**Anything Goes** - That means that you can enhance the image however you wish, you can cut and paste together different elements, change the background or do basically whatever you wish as long as it's your own work.
